

Golden Oval Eggs 12th Annual Meeting Attended by 150 Members Petersburg Reelected and Dahlager Joins Board of Managers

April 13, 2006, Renville, Minnesota. Golden Oval Eggs, LLC President and Chief Executive Officer Dana Persson. Approximately 150 people attended the Golden Oval Eggs 12th annual meeting held Wednesday, March 29 in Morton, Minnesota.

Chairman of the Board of Managers Chris Edgington reviewed the challenging industry market conditions during fiscal year 2005. He pointed out the achievements of Golden Oval Eggs continued growth and improvements, strengthening its competitive position in order to provide better services to customers.

Mr. Edgington also introduced this year's new members to the management team, Vice President of Supply Chain Bill Bloyer and Vice President of Human Resources and Chief Administration Officer Jerry Armstrong. He thanked retiring director Randy Tauer for his contributions to the Board of Managers since 2003.

President and Chief Executive Officer Dana Persson reported on the state of the egg industry and the core strengths of Golden Oval Eggs. According to Egg Industry Magazine, Golden Oval Eggs grew to 8th place from 13th in the industry in the 2005. Mr. Persson stated, "In the twelve years we have been in business, our growth represents one third of the egg product industry's growth. We are committed to move this company forward to a leadership position to ensure shareholders a profitable egg processing company."

Chief Financial Officer Doug Leifermann reviewed the financial performance at fiscal 2005-year end, the positive contributions from the completion of the Thompson, Iowa complex, as well as long-term debt restructuring to lower company interest expense.

Vice President of Supply Chain Bill Bloyer reported on the opportunities Golden Oval Eggs has as it grows. He also reported on increased bio-security measures in place to protect our birds, employees, and customers.

Shareholders reelected Brad Petersburg and elected Howard Dahlager to the board of managers for three-year terms.

Brad Petersburg was re-elected to a three-year term. He has served on the Board since June 1998, formerly as Chairman, Vice Chairman and an advisory member.

Mr. Petersburg has served various roles in developing farmer-owned, value-added business ventures including: founder and board member of EXOL; founder, board member, and project coordinator of Midwest Grain Processors; and founder and board member of Ag Ventures Alliance. He also helped organize and currently serves on the boards of the Iowa Renewable Fuels Association and BIOWA Development Association. Mr. Petersburg and two partners also formed Rural Development Associates, which provides business development services to agribusiness clients. He has owned and managed his farm since 1979, where he raises corn and soybeans in North Central Iowa.

Elected to the board for the first time, Howard Dahlager will serve a three-year term.

Since 1981, Mr. Dahlager has been a partner in JSF, Inc., In addition to farming; JSF distributes Stine seed throughout southern Minnesota. Previously, he raised certified seed, and built and operated a seed conditioning plant. Mr. Dahlager is an original member of Golden Oval Eggs. He has previously served on the Minnesota Crop Improvement Board as chairman and secretary and on the Minnesota Corn Processors Board as Chairman and Vice-Chairman. He is an officer of the Sacred Heart Lions Club and deacon and treasurer on his Church Board. A graduate of Moorhead State University, he also continued his studies at Mankato State University.

Golden Oval Eggs, LLC www.goldenoveggs.com was established in 1994 as a new generation value-added cooperative created, owned, and directed by agricultural producers. On September 1, 2004, the 700 shareholders of Golden Oval Eggs changed the company's corporate structure to a Limited Liability Company (LLC). Today Golden Oval Eggs is a leader in the liquid egg industry, ranked among the top 10 processors, serving customers throughout the United States and Canada.
